NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the Mullica Township Board of Education, Atlantic County, New Jersey, for the purchase of former school building and all real property on which the same is situated, land size 1.71 +/- acres, located at Block 9702, Lot 10, 1224 Darmstadt Avenue, Egg Harbor City, New Jersey.

Sealed bids will be received by the Mullica Township Board of Education located at PO Box 318, 500 Elwood Road, Elwood, New Jersey 08217 on or before 4:00 PM prevailing time, September 15, 2009 and will be publicly opened and read at 7:00 PM on September 15, 2009 at the Board of Education Public meeting. The bid in the minimum amount of \$75,000 to be accepted and must contain a 10% deposit of the total bid amount made to the Mullica Township Board of Education by certified check, bank check or bid bond with approved surety acceptable to the Board.

Bids must be made according to this advertisement, enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and proposal identification on the outside. It must be delivered to the Business Administrator/Board Secretary at the above place on or before the time named. The Board assumes no responsibility for bids mailed or misdirected in delivery.

The property and/or structure will be sold in "AS IS" condition, the Board not being responsible for any warranties, guarantees or statements made to buyers regarding condition, use, taxes or possible future use thereof.

No bid submitted hereby may be withdrawn for a period of sixty days after the date for opening of bids set forth above.

Acceptance or rejection of the bids shall be made no later than the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Education following the submission of bids. Final settlement of bid accepted shall be held within 45 days of final acceptance of the bid by the Board of Education.
